We are also **NOT** offering a delivery service this year so **ALL** orders must be picked up from the Scout Centre on the 1st May 2021. Appropriate social distancing etc will be enforce on the pickup day.

Payment

We can accept payment by the following :-

- Online (our bank details will be on the form)
- By post cheque or cash to me (address on the form)
- Or cheque, cash, contactless payment on the pickup day

However, on a positive note we have added some new plants to our list and removed some less popular items.

Just some quick notes on this year's order form.

The great news is that most of the plastic trays are now made from recycled drinks bottles and can be put straight in your blue bin (after washing) if you do not reuse them again yourself (we are still working on the bigger pots).
